Tu B'Shevat: New Year of Trees

Tu B'Shevat is the New Year of trees. It falls on the 15th day of Shevat on the Jewish calendar and on the civic calendar beginning on the eve of the 9th day of February and ending on the eve of the 10th. This is the season in which the earliest blooms of trees in Israel emerge from their winter sleep and begin a new fruit bearing cycle. Among some of the observances of this time is the eating of the fruits of Israel such as grapes, figs, olives, dates and pomegranates.

At the centre we celebrate by teaching the children

about trees and the benefits we enjoy because of trees. We also sing songs with the children and show them images of trees typically found in Israel. Teaching children how to identify trees is another great way to develop their love of trees. Start with trees with three letter names: elm, oak, fir and ash. Have fun finding them at the park or in your neighborhood!
