Preparing for Flu Season

Aleph-Bet will be taking the necessary measures to assist in keeping our children, families and staff healthy during this flu season. We ask that all families assist by washing their hands upon entry to the centre and prior to departure.

If your child has flu like symptoms such as a new cough and fever with sore throat, headache or fatigue please notify the centre and keep your child home until symptoms have subsided.

As per our program policy, children who are displaying symptoms such as fever, vomiting (1 bout), diarrhea (2 bouts) or are not participating in the program due to illness will be sent home to recover.

As part of our curriculum, we teach the children ways that they can prevent the spread of germs such as **cough and sneeze etiquette**: cough and sneeze into the crook of their arm; **frequent and effective hand washing**: working the soap, scrubbing tops and bottoms of hands and in between the fingers while reciting the ABCs.
