Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur

Rosh Hashanah

Rosh Hashanah marks the first and second day of the new year in the Jewish Calendar. This year it begins on the eve of September 29th with the first and second full day falling on the 30th and October 1st. It is the time to look back on

the previous year and reflect on mistakes made and resolve to make changes for the new year.

Work is not permitted during Rosh Hashanah and much of the time is spent at Synagogue. The machzor is a special prayer book which is read from at

this time. The shofar or ram's horn is blown in Synagogue 100 times over the two days for followers to hear signaling the new year. The shofar, however is not sounded if Rosh Hashanah falls on Shabbat.

Family and friends gather to share in the celebration and enjoy special meals and sweet



treats such as apples and honey.

Yom Kippur

Yom Kippur begins on the eve of October 8th and ends on the 9th. The first day is reserved for asking for forgiveness from promises broken between people. The second day is to ask G-d's forgiveness for broken promises. There are five restrictions during this time: eating and drinking, anointing ones' body with perfumes or lotions, marital relations, washing, and wearing leather shoes.

Seeds of Empathy

Aleph-Bet will be participating in our fourth year of SOE. This is a language and literacy program designed to foster social and emotional competence and early literacy skills and attitudes in children ranging from 3-5 years of age. We will be implementing the program with the 4 year old children starting in the fall. There are two major components: Literacy Circles and the Family Visits. During the Literacy Circle the Literacy Coaches read a two stories to the children and implement related activities over a two week period. In week three of each month the Family Guide leads the children in a Family Visit in which the community parent and infant spend time with the children and the children get to know all about the infant and his or her needs over a ten month period.

We look forward to meeting our new SOE family and the monthly visits around the purple blanket.
